## A word from Fr. Bill...

#### Dear Parishioners:

This Wednesday, the Augustinians celebrate the Feast of the Conversion of St. Augustine. This is when St. Augustine tells us that after a restless life he was in the garden and heard the words, "Tolle Lege," which means "Take up and Read." He picked up the scriptures and read the passage from Saint Paul's letter to the Romans: "Let us live honorably, as in the day, not in reveling and drunkenness, not in bodily pleasures, and sexual excess, not in quarreling and jealousy. Instead, put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh to gratify its desires." This was the climactic moment of St. Augustine's conversion. You will see this depicted in the first of the portraits of St. Augustine's life which is in the choir loft on the bridge side of the church.

It is on this feast that our Province has one of its major fundraisers of the year supporting our way of life and our ministries. Please find more information about the details of this fundraiser and how you can participate in it elsewhere in this bulletin as well as a flyer within the bulletin.

Please remember to join us for a segment of "The Chosen" after the 11:00 am Mass on Sunday, May 5. Also, please remember to pick up your bag for canned goods for the food pantry staffed by Padre Pio Center and return it on Manna Sunday, May 19th.

This past week, some extensive repairs were done on the fire escape of the Women of Hope residence. We were expecting to pass the regular inspection but it was discovered that \$12,240 worth of work was needed. This was not anticipated and consequently it was not budgeted. The repairs include reinforcing the railings along the wall of the building, strengthening the treads, and applying protective painting to the fire escape. I don't remember the bishop saying anything about treads, protective painting or fire escapes on the day of my ordination. Please see below this work in action and the lift on the right side of the stairs.


