



A word from Fr. Bill...

Dear Parishioners:

The primary purpose of our parish community is to celebrate the Eucharist (there is no parish without the Eucharist), increase our faith and share our faith with others in words and in deed. As the floor mats at the two entrances to the church say, "We gather to worship, We leave to serve." In order to do this, in good stewardship, we have the responsibility to maintain our parish property. In that vein, I want to keep you up to date on some of the physical plant improvements which are currently being addressed.

- ◆ The hand railings coming into the church from 4th Street as well as the hand railings going into the sanctuary are being strengthened, hopefully, they were this past Friday. (\$1,000)
- ◆ Three new automatic doors are going to be installed in the church. (The fire alarm system in the church has just been updated.) (\$35,000 for both projects, mostly paid by a grant) Doors will be installed around the 15th.
- ◆ A fire sprinkler system will shortly be installed in Carr Hall and the Women of Hope Residence. (\$71,300, most of which is being paid by grants)
- ◆ New windows will be installed in September on the Vine St. side of the Women of Hope building. This will complete the project of new windows for the entire building, with the exception of the Carr Hall windows. (\$61,650).
- ◆ Flower planters are being constructed outside of Carr Hall. (We are grateful for a parishioner who got the project started.)
- ◆ Repairs by mandate to the Fire Escape need to be completed by December. (\$12,500)
- ◆ Pruning of some trees by the courtyard will take place in September. Trees adjacent to the parking lot have recently been treated for some bug infestations.
- ◆ Contractors are looking at the ceiling above the lady's room in Carr Hall where there are constant leaks.
- ◆ A great deal of attention is being given to over \$300,000 of repairs which are needed for the tower of the church. The Steering Committee is investigating grants and fundraisers.
- ◆ We recently had repairs to the air conditioning system in the church. (\$1,600)
- ◆ We recently signed a contract for snow removal for next winter. (\$5,250)
- ◆ The lines in the parking lot were repainted this past Monday. (\$950)
- ◆ New WiFi access points were recently installed in the parish offices and friary. (\$980)

It is essential we have to pay attention to the physical needs of the parish plant in order that the celebration of the Eucharist and the pastoral needs of the parish can take place. Hopefully, the above information is helpful in keeping you up to date on some of the improvements which are currently being addressed.

I am extremely grateful to Adam Klukiewski, our Director of Maintenance, who is overseeing these projects and working with the contractors. Tim Babbage has been essential in sharing his expertise by his insights and suggestions. I and also all of us owe a great deal of gratitude to Jacob Marquart, O.F.S., our Director of Parish Services, all the members of our Parish Finance Commission and Steering Committee who advise me on all these matters. I literally would not be able to respond to this aspect of our parish needs without them.
