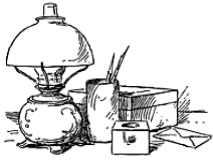

A word from Fr. Bill.....

Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Augustine Parish:

Welcome to the 2018 celebration of the Summer Sinulog. This twenty-six-year old tradition has become one of the high points of our parish year. It is a perfect opportunity for us to thank the Filipino community for being such an integral part of St. Augustine Parish. It is not an exaggeration to say we may not still be in existence as a parish if it were not for the Filipino community. Their involvement in the parish started in 1992 with the enthronement of the Santo Niño when Saint Augustine Parish became the National Shrine of the Santo Niño. It is a real source of inspiration to celebrate this with so many people from so many different places and with such devotion and enthusiasm.

We are extremely grateful that Fr. Peter Donahue, O.S.A., President of Villanova University, will be presiding and preaching at our liturgical celebration this year. This is most appropriate since Villanova has its roots right here in our parish. Welcome, Fr. Peter and thank you taking the time and making the effort to be with us.

In a very special way we are privileged that Archbishop Bernardito Cleopas Auza is joining us for our Sinulog celebration this year. Archbishop Auza who is originally from the Philippines is presently the Overseer of the United Nations for the Vatican. This basically means that he is the representative of Pope Francis to the United Nations. It is Archbishop Auza who communicates to the members of the United Nations the thoughts and feelings of Pope Francis about all the issues which it discusses. Thank you Archbishop Auza for honoring us with your presence and participation today.

Within our celebration this year, a longtime friend of St. Augustine Parish, Dr. Restituto Estacio, is being affiliated to the Augustinian Order. I say Dr. Estacio is a longtime friend of the parish because he was one of the leaders who approached Fr. Walter Quinn, O.S.A. in 1992 and was instrumental in our parish being the National Shrine for the Santo Niño. As laudable as this is, it is for other reasons for Dr. Estacio's affiliation.

His certificate of affiliation in part reads, "In view of your longstanding love and devotion to the Augustinian Sisters of the Monastery of Santo Niño, Mohon, Philippines, and of the Monastery of Saint Rita, Campina, Romania.....we affiliate you as a member of the Augustinian Order." This certificate is signed by Fr. Alejandro Moral Antón, O.S.A., the Prior General of the Augustinians throughout the world. Fr. Alejandro presided at our Summer Sinulog last year. Congratulations, Dr. Estacio. It is wonderful that our Prior General has recognized you for all the support you have given to our Augustinian Sisters in the Philippines and in Romania.
