

A word from Fr. Bill...

Dear Parishioners:

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany of Our Lord. Yesterday, we celebrated New Years' Day. How might they be connected?

Since childhood, we have been familiar with the story of the Magi in the midst of danger from Herod following the star and finding Jesus.

I remember as a little kid (just several years ago) every day after Christmas being able to move the Magi in the Nativity scene a little closer to the infant Jesus until the Feast of the Epiphany when they were at the manger with Jesus, Mary and Joseph.

I remember when I was first ordained and was at my first priestly assignment, the pastor had the letters on the wall which spelled out, "Three men sought him. Wise ones still do." Are we one of the wise ones who seek Jesus?

As we begin a new year, what stars will we follow in 2022 to find Jesus?

Like the Magi, sometimes in our environment today it may be risky to seek Jesus. We can be rejected. It may make us not as financially secure for one reason or another. We could lose friends. We might be ridiculed.

Herod wanted to kill anyone who might be a threat to his prestige and power. As this year unfolds, we can encounter Herods who are threatened by spirituality of maybe our relationship with Jesus or maybe the Church.

We have no idea of what will unfold in 2022. We are not expected to have a horoscope to know. We don't know what competition or risks there will be in searching for Jesus. That is why it is important to follow certain stars.

I heard a young couple the other night say they periodically watch a half hour video of different Saints. Reflection on the Saints and modeling their virtues are stars that lead me to Jesus.

Someone told me last week he had not been to confession in 11 years, and when he recently went (not with me), he discovered a peace he has not known for a while. The sacraments are stars that can lead us to Jesus.


A young man recently told me that his grandfather died a few weeks ago and that he had been coming to Mass during the week because "I find a connection." Participating in the faith community is a star that leads us to Jesus.

As you may be aware, there is a group in the parish who say the rosary together on Zoom each Tuesday night at 8 PM. There is another group that meets on Zoom on Thursday nights at 7 PM to share insights into the scripture passages for the following Sunday. "Where two or three are gathered in my name, there I am." You can find the Zoom information to connect to these groups on the homepage of our parish website and also in the bulletin. Being part of one or both of these groups may be stars that lead me to Jesus.

The Magi, in the midst of some risks, followed the star and experienced the physical manifestation of Jesus. What star(s) —Saints, Sacraments, Community, prayer groups - will I follow in 2022 to experience the manifestation of Jesus in my life?
