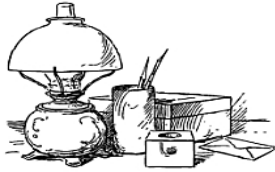

Dear Parishioners:

It is certainly important for us to see some light when there is so much darkness around us and to see new life when there is so much death around us. We had that great opportunity to experience light and new life during this past Easter Season when Ted Baker made a Profession of Faith to the Catholic Church, was Confirmed and received First Communion.

It was not only a new sense of light and new life for Ted but also for his sponsor, Ryan, his wife, Kharisma, our parish representative, Patrick and for our entire parish community. Ted, Ryan and Kharisma are now getting involved in our socials after the 7:00 PM Masses on Sunday evenings as well as a new initiative of working with Catholic colleges in the Philadelphia area and the young adults of our parish.

In the Gospel readings for the past several weeks, we have heard Jesus sending the chosen disciples out to share their faith with others. We also have been chosen and are called to do the same. There may be someone you know who knows nothing about this process of becoming Catholic, but would like to know. How will they know if you do not share this with them? By sharing this video with them, you could be an instrument to literally change their lives. By sharing this video, you may be the instrument to bring light and new life to someone as well as to our parish community.
