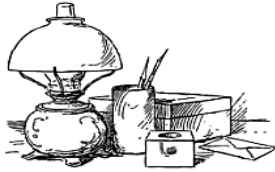

A word from Fr. Bill...

Dear Parishioners:

In the past nine years we have had approximately 25 Catechumens and Candidates participate in the process of Christian Initiation (RCIA). It is gratifying and amazing every year to see how much the sponsors of the Catechumens and Candidates get out of the process. More than once, sponsors have said "I wish I had not been confirmed at 14. Doing this process as an adult, I know so much more about my faith." In the recent video which I shared with you a few weeks ago, Ryan, the sponsor of Ted, says "After all my Catholic Education, I am now much more intentional about my faith." For each of the past nine years Patrick Lanza has participated in the process as a Parish Representative. Each year, he said he is enriched by the different participants and their individual faith journeys and he also has an opportunity to enrich theirs.

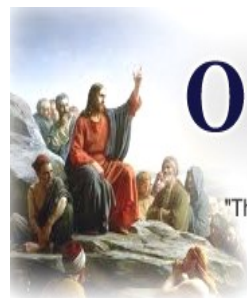
All of this has prompted me to invite any parishioners who may be interested to participate in this process with us. One parishioner, Brian, already has taken the initiative to participate with us next year. I consulted about this new opportunity with our Parish Staff, the 3-5 year Pastoral Plan Committee and our Parish Pastoral Council. They were all very encouraging to open this process to all interested parishioners. It was suggested that I discuss this with Fr. Dennis Gill, the Rector and Pastor at the Cathedral as well as the Director of Liturgy for the Archdiocese. He very much encouraged we do this. He said they do this at the Cathedral and they find it very fruitful for a number of reasons.

It is a wonderful way to update one's faith, to rekindle one's faith, to enrich one's faith, and to be a part of the faith journey of others. It is basically adult religious education. It is an extensive process as we meet in person on Monday nights (7:00 PM-8:30 PM. It is basically every Monday (not Christmas, New Years and a few other Mondays). We begin on Labor Day and end in May at Pentecost. We discuss basic areas of the faith: what is faith, the Holy Trinity, who is Jesus, how to use the Bible, how to understand revelation, various forms of prayer, the Church year, the role of the Pope and Bishops, Mary, the Saints, Eschatology (heaven, hell), each of the sacraments, Christian moral living, consistent ethic of life and social justice, the role of laypeople in the Church, living the faith, etc. I told you it was extensive.

If you think you would be interested in participating in this process in order to enhance your own faith, please be in touch with me and I would be very happy to meet with you and discuss this with you.
