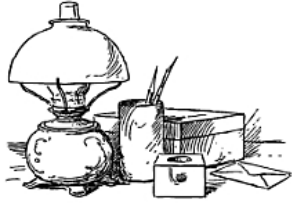

A word from Fr. Bill...

Dear Parishioners:

Our parish benefited a great deal this past weekend from the generosity of one of our relatively new parishioners, Brian Halpin. Brian volunteered a great deal of time Friday afternoon, all day Saturday, and Sunday morning sharing his competency in painting. Brian with the assistance on Saturday of his daughter, (amazing) Grace, painted a parlor in the friary. This room is used as a place where the friars often meet individuals.

I mention this, not only to thank Brian and Grace, for sharing their talents and time for our community, but it is an opportunity to thank so many others who donate time and competencies for the betterment of our parish. It is dangerous to name people or groups because one takes the risk of leaving someone out, but I am going to take that risk rather than not thank anyone.

I think of the many parishioners who donate their time and talents in order that our January and August Sinulog celebrations are beautifully celebrated. I think of those who organized our parish socials after the 3 Sunday Masses which I hope will be able to resume soon. I also think of volunteers who come in from the outside, like students from Malvern Prep and Villanova University. I am very grateful to have the staff we do, Tim Babbage, Jacob Marquart, O.F.S., and Kim Barroso who are resources and who support our volunteers.

We also have parishioners who share their time and gifts outside the parish, like at the Gift of Life Family House for transplant patients and their families.
