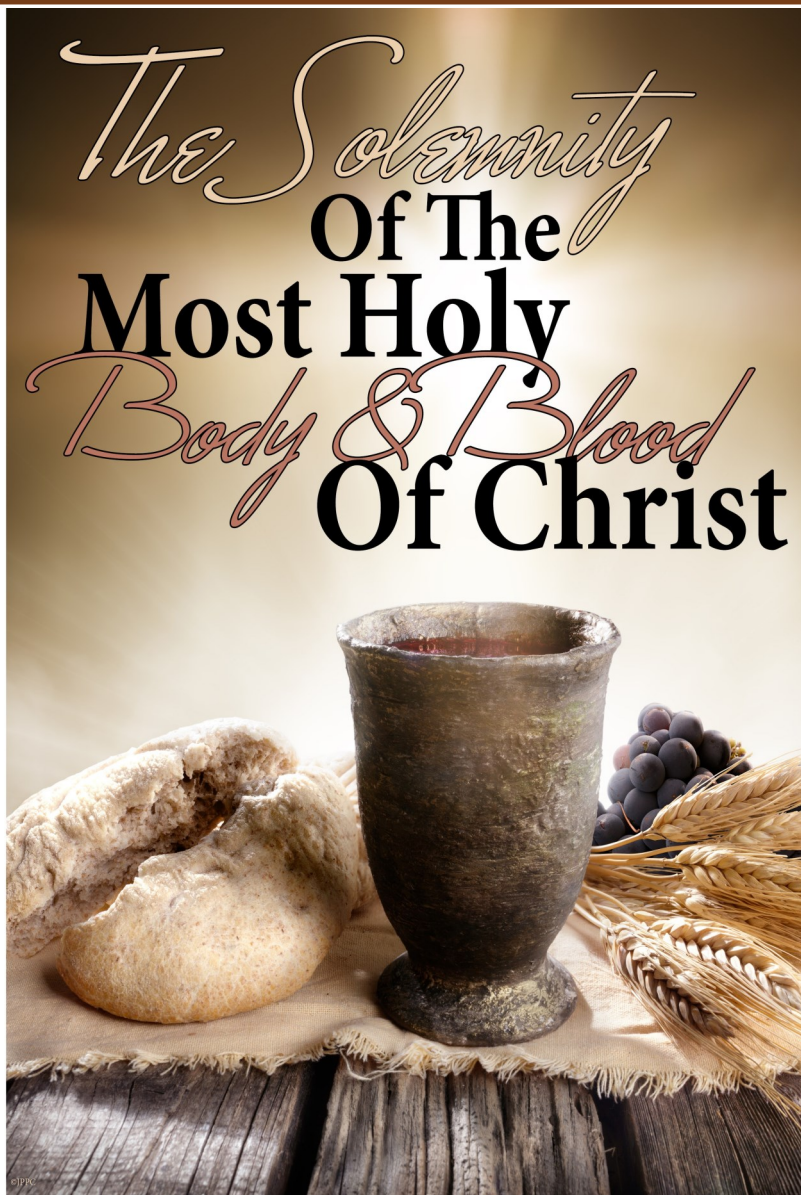

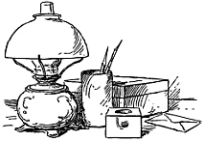

A word from Fr. Bill.....

Dear Parishioners:

Once again, I would like to remind you that we are beginning this Monday evening to discuss Pope Francis' Apostolic Letter entitled "With a Father's Heart." We are doing this in connection with the Pope proclaiming this year in honor of St. Joseph. The Pope has done this to give us an opportunity to reflect on the life and virtues of St. Joseph and hopefully to be inspired to integrate these virtues into our own lives. This is especially appropriate considering the challenges in family life in our society today. These discussions will take place on Zoom from 7:00 PM to 8:30 PM on the four Mondays of June: June 7, June 14, June 21 and June 28. This is an opportunity for us to share our faith with each other, to learn from each other, to continue to grow in our knowledge of our faith and to build our parish community. I will provide you with a copy of the Pope's letter. If you are interested in being part of these discussions, please sign up in the back of the church or let me know.

As I announced last weekend, we are now accepting nominations for the Parish Pastoral Council. We would like to replace the three current members who are leaving the Council with three new members. The term is three years. Ideally, we have the rotation of each year three members leaving the Council and three new members joining. I rely very heavily on the reflections, insights and input of the Council members concerning the pastoral life and pastoral needs of the parish. We meet once a month for about an hour and a half each month. If you would like to nominate someone, please check with that person first. It is perfectly acceptable to nominate yourself.

Talking about the Parish Pastoral Council, at our meeting on May 26th we discussed the topic of the Saturday evening Vigil Mass. As you know, because of the pandemic, there was a time last year that we were not able to have public Masses at all. The first weekend when we were permitted to have public Masses we had the Saturday Vigil Mass as well as the 3 Sunday Masses. There were very few parishioners at the Saturday Mass that weekend. After consultation with the Parish Pastoral Council at that time, it was decided to suspend the Saturday Vigil Mass throughout 2021. After consultation with the Council at our May 26th meeting, it was decided to suspend the Saturday Vigil Mass indefinitely. This decision was not made lightly. There were many factors taken into consideration. Some of the considerations were: the low number of parishioners who participated in this Mass before the pandemic, the priest personnel available to preside at this Mass, a more convenient time we could offer couples to celebrate their weddings on Saturday (many would have the wedding at 2 or 3 PM and have to be out of the church by 4:30 PM because of confessions but their reception might not start until 6:00 PM), the possibility of being able to accommodate more than one couple on a Saturday. It was mentioned by some Council members at last week's meeting that there is at least one Saturday Vigil Mass in the area for those who prefer an evening Mass that we will continue to have the 7:00 PM Mass on Sundays. We certainly hope that those who did participate in the Saturday Vigil Mass will understand all the considerations that went into this decision.

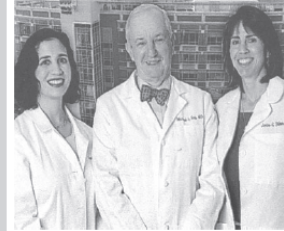
