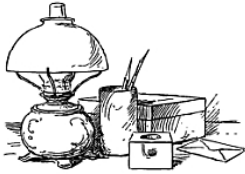

## *A word from Fr. Bill.....*

Dear Parishioners:

In the spirit of keeping you informed, I share with you the disappointing news that this week the parish received rejections for two grant applications. This is all in connection with the second phase of our Capital Campaign.

In Phase One of the campaign, we have received over \$700,000 in cash from parishioners, the Augustinian community and friends of the parish. In a recent communication to the parish, I outlined the various projects for which this money was used. Please visit the Capital Campaign link on our parish website for this information.

In Phase Two, working in collaboration with the Catholic Foundation of Greater Philadelphia, we recently applied to grants from Partners for Sacred Places and the Pennsylvania Historic and Museum Commission and we received rejections from both of them. We were seeking these grants to continue replacing louvers in the church steeple, for façade work in the upper level of the church tower, as well as for upgrading the fire alarm and the sprinkler systems, and replacing windows in the St. Augustine Community Center (residence of Women of Hope, the Augustinian Volunteers, the Women's Veterans Center and Carr Hall).

The Pennsylvania State Historic Preservation Commission did suggest we make an application to next year's (2021-2022) grant cycle. We certainly will follow up on this suggestion. The Catholic Foundation of Greater Philadelphia continues to pursue an overall plan for us to apply for grants for our parish needs.

I share all this with you as I think it is important for you to know the status of the Capital Campaign. The Steering Committee of the Campaign has been, and will continue to be, proactive to raise additional money for the necessary improvements of our historic parish property.

Please continue to keep this effort in your prayers.


