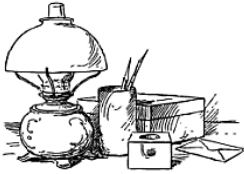

A word from Fr. Bill.....

Dear Parishioners:

Each year in the third week of June the members of our Augustinian Province, the Province of St. Thomas of Villanova, meet for prayer, fraternal sharing, input on the state of the province, and to look at what issues with which we need to address, and surface some direction to take. This usually takes place each year on the campus of Villanova University. Because of the pandemic, last year's gathering and this year's gathering took place on Zoom. This past week as many as 80 of us met at different times on Tuesday and Wednesday mornings and afternoons. Naturally, all four of us in our local community participated in all four sessions. We began by remembering the 13 friars of our province who died since we met a year ago. We heard the realistic numbers that of approximately 120 members of our province, there are only 10 friars under the age of 50 and only 20 friars under the age of 60.

Looking at our reality, we are committed to reflect on our gifts, talents, and resources and use them very effectively as we move forward. One of our great resources is the quality and enthusiasm of our younger friars. The quality of these young men along with their commitment and sincerity gives us a great deal of encouragement and inspiration as we make adjustments and plan for the future. We are very blessed that three of our young friars will be ordained to the priesthood next Saturday.

We discussed using our imaginations of what we would see as the possibilities for us as a province in the future, respecting the present but open to new possibilities. In the spirit of being appreciative and thankful for the past, we want to hear the dreams especially from our younger friars but certainly accompanied with the wisdom and experience of the more seasoned friars. We want this to be framed keeping in mind the contemporary issues of our Church and our society.

Our present Prior Provincial, Fr. Michael DiGregorio, OSA is entering his eighth year of two terms as serving as Provincial. He cannot be reelected. So, on Wednesday afternoon we discussed in small groups and in the large group what characteristics we would like to see in the next provincial who will begin his term this time next year. We discussed what issues need to be addressed next year at our Ordinary Provincial Chapter (gathering of the whole Province) which takes place every four years. This meeting is called a Legislative Chapter as it will give very specific directions for the following four years. We discussed on Wednesday various suggestions of how the process will take place in the next year, the process of surfacing specific concrete issues to be addressed next summer and the process of surfacing names for the next Provincial.

The sessions were very profitable and encouraging.

I think it is important you know some of the "doings" of our Augustinian life.

Please keep us in prayer as we continue with the process and have a SAFE week.
