Parish Committees

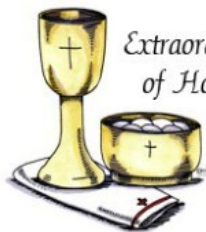

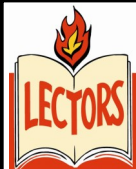

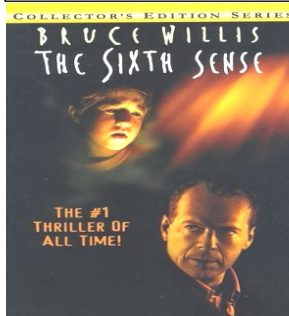
