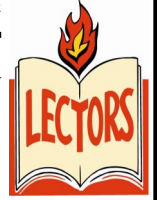
### Condo Outreach Ministry

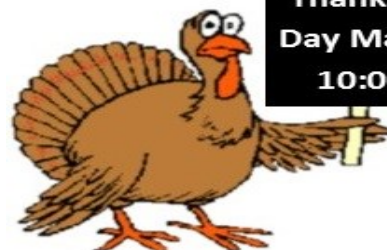

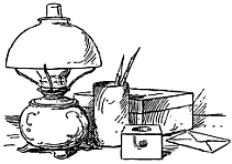

## *A word from Fr. Bill...*

Dear Parishioners:

In November of 2018, our Parish Pastoral Council recommended that our parish participate in a parish survey facilitated by The Catholic Leadership Institute. In early 2019, 107 of our parishioners took part in this survey. The input we received from the survey was that we were a very welcoming, hospitable community with excellent music and very good homilies (Well, most of the time maybe). It also indicated many people did not understand some of the basics of our faith and those who did were reluctant to share their faith.

As a result, a committee was formed (of course) to affirm the positive and respond to the weaknesses which surfaced from the survey. This committee (Bill Castro, Dan Petrongolo, Maria Roberts-Reyes, Jacob Marquart, OFS and I) developed an Advent and Lenten program on Zoom centered on the Sacraments, covering their theological and practical aspects. Each week we had about 30 participants from around the Archdiocese, including several from our parish along with a guest expert presenter at each session. We would love to see the number from our parish grow.

A few of the comments on our Advent and Lenten series were:

*"What a wonderful program overall, and last night's program on the Eucharist with Father Gill was really informative for me, because he was not only knowledgeable but also personable."*

*"Thank you so much. These talks have given me new perspectives to share with my catechists who teach the Sacraments and also our RCIA team, as well as with those preparing to be welcomed into the Church. Great format, too. God bless."*

*"Linda and I thought the three-part series was excellent. We look forward to participating during Lent. The format was very good."*

*"Thank you for organizing these zoom events. They have made me feel more connected to my faith, especially during this trying time."*

*"I was a public school student when I was confirmed about 50 years ago. There were some catechism classes about the gifts of the Holy Spirit but I really had no clue what it was all about. I've learned more tonight than the rest of my life put together."*

*"The Lenten series on the Sacraments was a wonderful experience, and the final presentation on "How Does It All Come Together?" with Msgr. Magee was an extraordinary and engaging evening."*

This is all a long introduction (no surprise) to remind you (there have been inserts in the bulletin for several weeks and it has been posted on the homepage of our parish website) that during Advent this year we are continuing this program. This year is on the topic of the Mass.....*"Everything You Always Wanted To Know About The Mass, But Were Afraid To Ask"*...with some very qualified speakers. All the sessions are on Zoom from 7:00 PM to 8:30 PM on Tuesday evenings: November 30, December 7, 14 and 21. Please mark your calendars and register for the sessions. You have to register for each session that you wish to attend. Secondly, please post this on your own Facebook Page. Those of you who receive this electronically are receiving the flyer attached. Please share it far and wide. Just doing that is a great way of sharing our faith and letting others know this is going to take place.

Hopefully, the very positive response of those who participated last year and the quality of our presenters this year will be an incentive to want to be a part of this program this Advent and to share it with others.

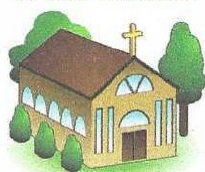
