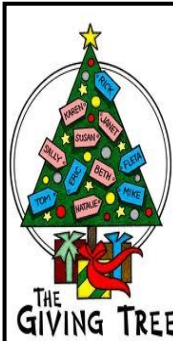

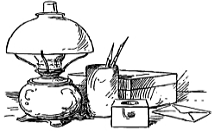

A word from Fr. Bill...

Dear Parishioners:

I hope everyone had a wonderful Thanksgiving and that your turkey wasn't burnt.

In the spirit of Thanksgiving, I would like to remind you of what you heard in the announcements at Mass for the past several weeks, in my letters here in the bulletin, and hopefully have seen on our parish website. This Tuesday is "Giving Tuesday," "#iGiveCatholic."

The "#iGiveCatholic" campaign is a bishop-led initiative in collaboration with the United States Bishop Conference and individual (arch)dioceses to inspire and support generosity. It is an independent 501(c)(3) organization.

I understand about \$20 million dollars was raised last year from this campaign. This year is the first time that we are participating in this campaign. We are one of 169 organizations and one of 38 parishes in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia to do so. Catholic grammar and high schools and nonprofit ministries also are participating this year.

You can participate by responding to an email you received from us on Thursday, November 16th or one that you will receive on Monday, November 27th. You also can just go to our parish website and follow the link to #iGiveCatholic. We are reaching out not just to you, our parishioners, but also to friends of the parish, businesses with whom our parish deals, couples who have been married here over the years, and those who have participated in our RCIA process for the past nine years.

Participants will be given the opportunity to donate to St. Augustine Parish in order to help finance one of a number of various activities in the parish. For example, one can help support the cost of updating the sound system in the church or help support the expense to video the faith witness stories of four parishioners or help support the repairs to the tower which are directed by the City of Philadelphia or help support several more security cameras for the property or help support the general operating expenses of the parish.

Obviously, we ask that you be supportive of this new initiative in the parish. But we also ask something else. Would you please pass this request on to your family and friends asking them to support us as well? Please use contact lists you may have as well as other social media outlets like Facebook and Instagram.

There are signs of new life in the parish. We are initiating several new programs: the development of a young adult group, reaching out to inactive Catholics, and videoing witness reflections of four of our parishioners which will be seen on our parish website. Another sign of new life is the initiative of the "#iGiveCatholic" campaign which in the past has been part of many other Catholic parishes, high schools, colleges, hospitals, etc.

This is all very promising. Please consider participating this coming Tuesday in "#iGiveCatholic."

You have heard it announced for the last several weeks, have seen the flyers in the bulletin and perhaps you have seen the announcement on our parish website that this Friday, December 1 at 7:30 PM our annual pre-Christmas concert will take place (actually this year it is also a pre-Advent concert). It is entitled "With the Angels, Let Us Sing!" Please join us and invite your family and friends.

Next Sunday is the 1st Sunday of Advent, the beginning of a new liturgical year. Next weekend in the pews will be parish registration forms. Many people worship with us but never register. Registration is important in order for us to have as an accurate number as possible of parishioners when the Archdiocese takes its annual census. It also is important for individuals when they need Letters of Eligibility to be a Godparent or permission to be married in another parish. If you are not registered here, please fill out one of the papers in the pew and leave it in the designated box in the back of the church.

Next Sunday at the 7:00 PM Mass we will celebrate the Rite of Acceptance with our Catechumen, Bryan Sobchuk. This is part of the Christian Initiation process. Since the beginning of September, Bryan, his sponsor (Kathrina Inchoco), three parishioners (Frank Hoban, Patrick Lanza, and Brian Halpin) and I have been meeting every Monday night. That is what is called the time of "Inquiry" when many topics about the faith have been discussed (e.g. what is faith, who is Jesus, how to use a Bible, revelation, the Mass, the Saints, and Mary, etc.). Bryan was baptized Catholic but never received the other Sacraments of Initiation which he will receive on the Sunday after Easter, April 7th. Please keep Bryan in your prayers as he continues this process preparing to be confirmed and receive First Holy Communion.

Have a great week and may it be a great "Giving Tuesday" for us in the parish.


