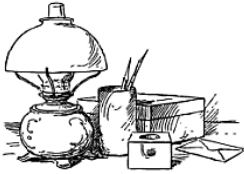

## *A word from Fr. Bill...*

Dear Parishioners:

Last call for new Lectors: As you know from the announcement in the bulletin a few weeks ago and the announcements at Mass for the past two weeks, there will be a workshop (in person) in Carr Hall on Wednesday, October 6 (7:00 to 8:30 PM) for new Lectors. This is an important liturgical ministry. Vatican II (the 1960's) called for an active participation of all the faithful at liturgies. Until that time there was little participation of the laity. They were mostly passive. Good liturgy calls for the involvement of all participating in the Mass. One of those roles is proclaiming God's Word. God wants to communicate with us. One of the primary ways this happens is God reveals (thus called revelation) God's relationship with us in the scriptures. It is truly a ministry to serve other parishioners. We are in need of Lectors, especially at the 9:00 AM and 7:00 PM Sunday Masses. If someone would like to sign up for the 11:00 AM Mass, that is certainly fine. Right now, there are 6 parishioners who have indicated they will be part of this workshop. Last Call: If you would like to serve the community as a Lector, please sign up in the back of the church and I will be in touch with you about details.

In the near future you will be seeing a great deal of activity improving our parish property. The renovations to the tunnel between the church and Carr Hall have been completed and paid for (\$43, 500). The new ramp will be installed soon (\$37,804). The lights on the steeple clock have not been lit for some time now, and will shortly be replaced (\$10,000, including electric work). Louvers in the church tower will finally be replaced (\$77,124). The windows facing the church in the 2nd and 3rd floors of the Parish Center will be replaced soon (\$48,000).

I am happy to say that we have the money on hand to pay for these improvements. The money for the tunnel and handicap ramp has been put aside over time from the offertory collection in a reserve fund. The majority of the money for the lights in the steeple is available from the profits of the Sinulog this past August. Contributions to the Capital Campaign have made it possible to replace the louvers. Money saved each month from the rent for the Women of Hope residence has made it possible to replace those windows.

Obviously, a great deal of work and consultation have gone into finalizing these projects. I am extremely grateful to the Steering Committee and to the members of the Parish Finance Commission for the many hours of deliberation and consultation in the navigation of all these projects. I am grateful to the law office of the Archdiocese who has provided incredible advice concerning contracts. I am most grateful to Bob Zigmund, our Facilities Director, for his incredible involvement with all the vendors in the facilitation of all these projects. Most importantly, regardless of the source of the income (Sinulog, Capital Campaign, Rent, Offertory Collection) it is the generosity of you, our parishioners, who makes it possible to maintain our historic property. Your generosity through the pandemic has been incredible and certainly inspirational. I thank God for you and your commitment to our parish community.
