Parish Committees

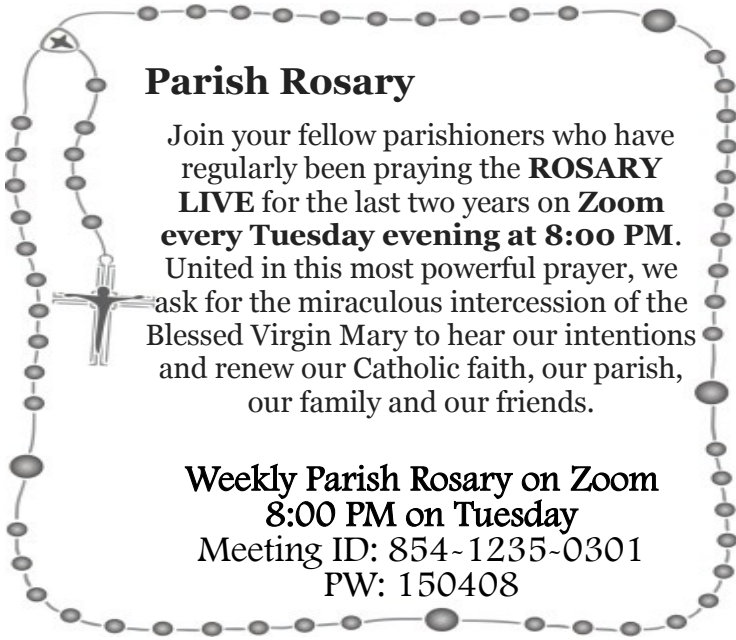

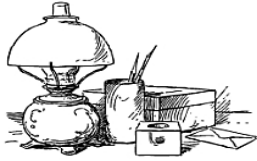

A word from Fr. Bill...

Dear Parishioners:

A few months ago, after the Supreme Court overturned the Roe v. Wade decision concerning abortion, I said in a weekly letter that I didn't think the Church did a good enough job of letting people know where there is help for women and couples who are looking for an alternative to abortion. I mentioned this to the Family Life Office of the Archdiocese. I doubt it was because of my suggestion as I find that hard to believe, but the Family Life Office recently published a 96-page pamphlet entitled:

Peace Be With you Pregnancy Care Related Resources

The pamphlet lists 12 Pregnancy Care Centers within Philadelphia, including their addresses and phone numbers, that provide programs and services to help those thinking about an abortion, as well as alternatives to abortion and post-abortion healing services (Project Rachel).

This pamphlet also includes resources in Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery, Berks Lancaster, Lebanon, Lehigh, Northampton, and York Counties as well as locations in Delaware and New Jersey.

What services are provided at these centers? To name a few: pregnancy and parenting counseling and education, free pregnancy tests, ultrasounds, food pantries, diaper pantries, baby boutiques, housing assistance, adoption services, health literacy, educational workshops and other supportive services. The agencies can make referrals for medical support, financial resources, housing, legal advice and professional counseling.

So often it is said that there are no alternative resources to help someone(s) who is thinking about an abortion. One will find in this pamphlet many resources to help those seeking such information. Each center can be a little different in what it provides. I will leave 5 of these pamphlets in the book rack in the back of the church. Please be sure to take one if you think the information would be helpful to you or someone else. If these are gone, we can order more. One also could get the pamphlet from the Family Life Office of the Archdiocese, 215-587-5661.

If you know anyone seeking information or seeking support and assistance for an alternative to abortion, please make this pamphlet available to them. Your assistance may save a life.

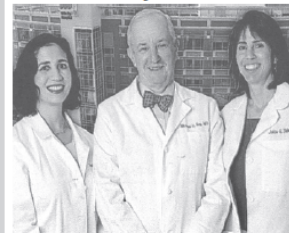

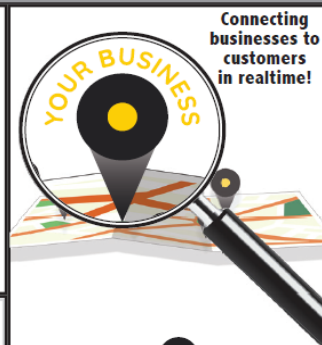

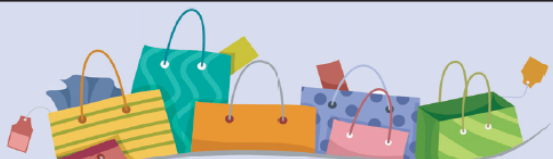
